WHY SHOULD TRAIN OPERATORS CARE ABOUT LIVE EVENTS DATA



Live events (music, sport, festivals, days out) are one of the prime movers of leisure travel. In fact, Eventbrite estimates that a staggering 35% of the UK visitor economy is driven by live events. This presents opportunities to service more customers, and also presents challenges in managing overloaded networks.

HOWEVER.



Live events data has to be collected from a huge number of different providers



It is messy and fragmented. Providers use different ticketing platforms, none of which talk to each other



Live events information changes all the time. Events can be cancelled and rescheduled to new dates at the drop of a hat.



This means that collecting events is hard. It was very time-consuming for TransPennine Express to keep up to date and reduced their ability to complete other important tasks



THIS IS WHERE DATA THISTLE COMES IN



TransPennine Express had historically collected live events information by hand, manually tracking arena venues, logging annual festival dates, and monitoring an ever-changing sports fixture list. Using lat/longs from CRS codes, Data Thistle provides all of this information automatically through a daily updated feed. TransPennine Express curate the data by date, time, distance, event type and capacity to create a bespoke set of information best suited for their network. Because Data Thistle acquires data automatically from source, train planning managers have maximum time between receiving the information and finalising important decisions around routes. This enables TransPennine Express to get the information to every necessary department quickly and efficiently, leading to better operational decisions around service provision. Smarter data-driven decisions ensure that passengers reach their final destinations more smoothly and help to better connect the wider UK rail network.
